- The student must have a 2.75 GPA or above.
- The student must agree to enroll as a full-time student at a state-accredited college, university, or technical/trade school.
- The student must agree to attend classes as prescribed by the school's curriculum for the semester for which tuition is paid.
- All applicants must be available for an interview.

**In all cases the LSM Board of Directors will have the final decision on eligibility of each applicant, and, if for any reason an applicant is found to be ineligible by the scholarship committee, the scholarship shall not be awarded.**
